Workshop Fees:

Franklin Island workshop is \$599.00 plus HST, registration is done online by visiting www.PhotoTourTrekking.com select Franklin Island Workshop and then click register, top left corner on tour page.

Fee includes 3 nights accommodations, Snug Harbour Cabins, daily workshops, 4 boat trips to Franklin Island, night photography at Killbear Provincial Park, day photography at Killbear Provincial Park & Welcome BBQ

Please Note: We will go out to the island rain or shine. Only time we won't go out is during thunder/lightning storms & rough water. If weather turns bad we will make a determination on whether we go to the Island or return to the resort early. We will do software training (Lightroom and Photoshop) as we also have a club house area for group gatherings. Killbear Provincial Park is our back-up if we can't get to the island.

FRANKLIN ISLAND WORKSHOPS ITINERARY:

DAY 1: Participants arrive in the afternoon and settle in Snug Haven Resort. Around 6:00 p.m., if everyone has arrived, there will be a BBQ followed by an orientation in the evening at approximately 7:30 pm.

DAY 2: Gather at the resort dock early morning. We sail to Franklin Island, about 10 minutes. We will stay on the island until 10:00 -11:00 a.m. earlier if the light fails us. Then sail to the island again at 3:30 pm & finish by 6:30- 7:00 pm, or later depending on the sunset. When we return to the resort. A light supper served and we will review images shot that day or night shoot.

DAY 3: Gather at the resort early morning. Today we will sail to another location on Franklin Island, finishing between 10:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m. This is contingent on the light. In the afternoon, we will sail to a couple of other locations that are quite unique in their own way and finish off around 6:30-7:00 pm, depending on the sunset. When we return to the resort. A light supper served and we review images or night shoot at Killbear. (on night 2 or 3)

DAY 4: Gather in the early morning. Optional visit to Killbear Provincial Park if weather was not co-operative day 2 or 3. Depart the resort at 11:00 a.m.

During the course of workshops we will do some long exposure night photography if the skies are clear on night 2 or 3. In particular the Milky Way.
