

Remembrance Day Nov 11th

Why the poppy became the symbol of remembrance ... Flanders is the name of the whole western part of Belgium. It saw some of the most concentrated and bloodiest fighting of WWI. This area was left muddy barren ... nothing survived. Poppies only survive in rooted up soil and with the warm weather of spring, the poppy flowered each year, brought life, hope, colour and reassurance to those still fighting.

John McCrae, a doctor serving with the Canadian Armed Forces, was deeply moved by what he saw, and in 1915 in his pocket book scribbled down the poem "In Flanders Fields. His poem eventually was published and the poppy became a popular symbol for all soldiers who died in battle. We must remember now and always.

The great thing is you can follow along from home via our Trekkers Blog on the website. Check back daily and don't forget we love to read your comments, so don't be shy.





India February 2013 - We are pleased to announce our second tour to India February 3rd to the 17th, 2013. This tour has limited space, we can take 15 photographers, we currently have 4 spaces available.

Our trek in February will have a similar schedule to the November tour. In November we will be attending the Pushkar Festival and on the February trek we will experience the Maha Kumbh Mela festival in

Allahabad. The Mela festival occurs once every 12 years and we will be there to capture it. Flying from Delhi to Varanasi will also be part of this trek.

Our schedule for this tour includes Delhi, Jaipur, and Agra which is famous for the Taj Mahal. While in Jaipur we will be visiting the Amber Fort located high on a mountain slope, we will ride via elephant to the top. And if you enjoy wildlife, our three Safari game drives at Ranthambore National Park to capture India's wildlife including the tiger will top off your photography experience.

Our India Photo Tour is \$5990.00 CAD per person plus air taxes of \$720.00, based on double occupancy, single supplement is an additional \$1595.00. Package price includes KLM International flights and return internal India flights from Delhi to Varanasi. India - Getting to know India - Ranthambore National Park



Getting to know India - Facts and interesting information about Incredible India. Here's an opportunity for the photographers that are joining us on our India tour, and followers of our newsletter to learn a little more about India, her culture and people.

This issue's feature Ranthambore National Park.



Ranthambore National Park is one of the biggest and most renowned national park in Northern India. The park is located in the Sawai Madhopur district of southeastern Rajasthan, which is about 130 km from Jaipur. Being considered as one of the famous and former hunting grounds of the Maharajas of Jaipur, today the Ranthambore National Park terrain is major wildlife sanctuary that has pulled the attention of many wildlife photographers and lovers of nature and preservation this destination.

The National park is spread over an area of 1,334 square kilometers. The park is majorly famous for its tigers and is one of the best locations in India to see the majestic predators in its natural habitat. The tigers can be easily spotted even during the day time busy at their ordinary quest hunting and taking proper care of their young ones.

The Ranthambore fort is believed to have been built in 944 A.D. by a Chauhan ruler. It is strategically located on the border of Rajasthan and erstwhile Malwa The Undulating topography of the surrounding forests was used as an outer defense to the advantage of the fort. It was one of the strongest forts of Northern India and surrounded by the Ranthambore National Park.

The fort had many buildings inside of which only a few have survived the ravages of wars and time. Among the remaining ruins, the two pavilions, Badal Mahal and Hammirs court and parts of the royal palace give an idea of the old grandeur. For water supply there are two rain fed reservoirs in the fort. The fort also has an old temple devoted to lord Ganesh which attracts many pilgrims and visitors every day.

Today the fort is overrun by vegetation the scattered remains of the chattris, summer palaces, and crumbling the guard posts can still be seen – reminders of a historic past set within a Wild present.

The entrance today, protects a treasure of greater value, one of the finest habitats in the world for the **TIGER**.



Africa at it's best the fall of 2013, this trek will reward photographers with beauty beyond belief. The Namibia desert is to be experienced besides photographed.


